




Round Rock ISD Police Dept. Commendation Form

On 10/13/21 at approximately 1715 hours, I (Sgt. Gauvin #504) was assigned to assist with traffic control for the Round Rock High School Homecoming parade. It was around this time that I was approached by a young man in crisis [REDACTED] had cut himself numerous times with a sharp piece of glass that he found on the roadway. He was bleeding from his arms and stated that he needed help. I began treating [REDACTED] and contacted Williamson County EMS as well as Round Rock Police Department to assist in this incident.

Upon checking [REDACTED] through the Williamson County Dispatch Center, I received a phone call from Ofc. Luis Marquez. Ofc. Marquez advised me that he knew [REDACTED] and that he was a pretty good kid. He stated that he does very well while in school but hates his home life. I asked Ofc. Marquez about [REDACTED] and he told me about his interest in the military. I then let Ofc. Marquez go so that I could continue to attend to [REDACTED]

Because [REDACTED] was in an elevated state, I began to speak to him about Ofc. Marquez. [REDACTED] demeanor changed entirely. He began telling me about how Ofc. Marquez and him sometimes meet up and talk. He mentioned how sometimes Ofc. Marquez will buy him McDonalds and sit down with him at lunch to eat it. He also said how Ofc. Marquez talks to him about the military and has inspired his own interest in serving our country. It was clear that Ofc. Marquez has gone above and to connect with this troubled child.

Ofc. Marquez has demonstrated through his actions that he is committed to the values and purposes of this agency. He is commended for his going above and beyond the call of duty to make a real connection with a child who needs it. Well done Officer Marquez and thank you for your service to this District.
